Mon, Oct. 8 Santa Fe, NM

With everyone aboard our motorcoach we will be on our way to the "Land of Enchantment" and our tour to include Albuquerque, Santa Fe and Durango. Today will be a day to

get acquainted with fellow travelers and to share in everyone's excitement. Tonight we overnight in Santa Fe, the capital city of New Mexico.

Tue, Oct 9 Durango, CO

Today we begin with some of the city's highlights. Old Santa Fe will include visits to Cathedral of St. Frances of Assisi and Loretto Chapel, whose spiral stairway is 22 feet high, has no center support and was assembled with wooden pegs instead of nails. Free time is allowed for strolling the Plaza where you will see many Native American artisans selling their crafts. You will have the option of visiting The Palace of the Governors (admission required). Built in 1610, it was the seat of government under Spanish, Native American, Mexican and U.S. territorial rule until 1909. Mid-afternoon we depart for Durango, CO.

Wed, Oct 10 Durango, CO

We will all be excited this morning as we board the Durango and Silverton Narrow Gauge Train at the depot in Durango. The train travels 45.4 miles along the Animas River to Silverton while the train

crosses the river 5 times en route. In Silverton, enjoy time for lunch and shopping in this former silver mining town with an elevation of 9318.

Thu, Oct 11 Farmington, NM

Heading to the west, our first stop will be Mesa Verde National Park, created in 1906 to protect some of the best preserved cliff dwellings in the world. Our visit will afford you great photo opportunities and a better understanding of the Ancestral Pueblo people who made it their home. Leaving the park, we route to 4-Corners, the only point in the US where 4 states (Arizona, Colorado, New Mexico and Utah) come together at one place. Navajo artisans and

vendors will be nearby selling jewelry and other crafts. We continue to Farmington, the commercial hub of northwestern New Mexico, to overnight.

Fri, Oct 12 Albuquerque, NM

Today we route to Albuquerque, the largest city in the state. The Rio Grande River runs through the city and the Sandia Mountains form a beautiful backdrop to the area. The word "Sandia" means watermelon in Spanish and the mountains glow a watermelon pink at sunset. The city will be filled with tourists in town for the 2018 Albuquerque International Balloon Fiesta and this evening we will attend the Balloon Glow followed by a spectacular fireworks display.

Sat, Oct 13 Albuquerque, NM


